## PINOT NOIR

100% Pinot Noir sourced atop the hills of Carneros, overlooking Napa Valley. This medium bodied red has notes of black raspberry, spiced oak, sweet tobacco, bitter orange, and cocoa. Silky tannins, bright cherry and juicy pomegranate. A bright and delicate pinot with a long fresh finish.

# **SAUVIGNON BLANC**

2019 Vintage

Cedar Lane Vineyard, Arroyo Seco 14 barrels produced (14.2% ABV)

2017 Vintage was Awarded the BEST WHITE WINE IN CALIFORNIA With a DOUBLE GOLD MEDAL 2018 California State Fair

This small production single-vineyard vintage was tank-fermented and aged in stainless steel sur lees for 6-months to heighten its bright and creamy aspects. Ripe, with fresh notes of melon, and a touch of lime zest. Well-balanced with bright acidity, lively minerality and a lingering finish make this wine a crisp and refreshing expression of the varietal.

This August we are proudly featuring our 2018 Pinot Noir and 2019 Sauvignon Blanc. For safety reasons, the California State Fair has been cancelled this year, so we have decided to celebrate in our own way by sending you home with two of our top-rated wines! In 2018 the Sauvignon Blanc was awarded "Best White Wine in California", and our Pinot Noir was awarded "Best Pinot Noir in California" in both 2018 & 2019. Cheers to our talented winemaking team for continuing to produce these world class wines!

Barrel-aged for 20 months in a combination of French & American oak (50% new barrels), this smooth, fruit forward wine adeptly balances acidity with bursts of red fruit flavors. Very drinkable now, and the nicely integrated tannins will permit its elegance to gradually unfold in the bottle through 2027.
